I did not hear about or see any members of crew until by return to UK.

Did source examina the wrockage of the plane? If so, what was its condition?

If the plane crashed in water how for was the plane fremeland and by whit worms was source rescued and what life refts, wreckers, etc., remained on the curface that would have assisted other personnel to keep affort.
